Scholarship Program 2012-2013 Briefing Document and Checklist

Annually, the Association of International Petroleum Negotiators sponsors a scholarship awarded to students who demonstrate a strong character, academic ability and potential to make a significant contribution to the field of international oil and gas negotiations. This scholarship has been created in the honor of one of AIPN's founding members, Gordon Barrows.

Award: USD\$5,000 annual (\$2,500 for each consecutive semester) for tuition only, paid directly to the school.

Candidates: Both undergraduates and graduates studying at one of the following schools of higher education.

To qualify, applicants must:

- Possess potential to make a significant contribution to the field of international oil and gas negotiations.
- Exhibit academic, leadership and negotiation ability.
- Exhibit financial need
- Complete all parts of the application form
- Submit copies of each of the following in one e-mail: (Scanned pdf documents are preferred)
 - current school transcript,
 - the AIPN Scholarship Program application
 - applicable entrance exam scores
- Submit two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals who can speak from personal knowledge concerning the applicant's character, ability, and potential to make a significant contribution to the field of international oil and gas negotiations. **Please note:** If you are currently in school, one reference **MUST** be from a school professor.
- Deliver all necessary forms in one e-mail to AIPN by June 1, 2012. Applications received after this date or incomplete applications will not be considered.

The selection of the recipients will be at the sole discretion of the AIPN. The AIPN reserves the right to award up to 8 scholarships or none at all. Previous scholarship winners are not eligible to participate again.

Applicants will be notified of results on or about July 9, 2012.
