



AIPN Summer Assistantship Program

Summer 2019

The AIPN Summer Assistantship Program recognizes the desire and need students may have for academically rewarding summer employment. AIPN has established funding for one summer assistant position to support an Education Advisory Board member in their research project.

EAB members are invited to identify student candidates from their oil and gas related classes, with the EAB member selecting a research topic of relevance to the EAB member's own research, writing, and teaching.

How to Apply: EAB members should complete the application for the 2019 Summer Assistantship Program and submit a short letter explaining the nature and significance of the proposed research project, as well as the reasons the EAB member selected the student candidate for the research assistant position.

Eligibility: Student must be enrolled in Oil and Gas related courses.

Number of positions available: 1

Length of Position: 8-10 weeks between May 21 and August 9, as determined by professor

Deliverable: Upon conclusion of the program, the student assistant is expected to provide a 2-3 page summary of his or her experience.

Deadline to Apply: April 25, 2019

Winners Announced: May 1, 2019

Stipend of: \$5,000 for the position, divided into two payments at the start and finish of the program
